Admission to Major in Modern Languages

A 3.0 GPA is required in 1441-2314 Modern Language sequence or a grade of B on the CLEP Exam, or departmental approval. After admission, Modern Language majors must maintain a 2.75 in major classes.

NOTE: Degree requires 120 academic hours. At least 36 hours must be at the 3000/4000 level: 24 in the major, 6 in the minor and an additional 6 hours. At least 25 percent of the degree must be earned at the University of Texas at Arlington, including 18 advanced hours (3000/4000) at which 12 must be within the major. No more that 72 hours from Community or Junior College may be applied.
